School Committee Members present: Chairman Phyllis Guerette, Warren Caruso, Kate Dickerson, Nichi Farnham, Beth Grant, and Jay Ye. Vice Chair Christine Szal was unable to attend.

A. 1.&2. The Bangor School Committee Special Meeting was called to order by Chairman Phyllis Guerette at 7:00 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

B. Superintendent Webb requested amending the agenda to remove F.d. Approval of Food Service Agreement with Brewer School Department.

VOTED 6-0 to amend the agenda as requested.

D. 1. Director of Business Services Alan Kochis updated the School Committee on the Qualified School Construction Bond process. The Bangor City Council is scheduled for a public hearing and then a final vote on July 11, 2011. The total amount borrowed of the approved seven million will be approximately \$5.7 million. The remaining funds will return to the Maine Department of Education.

E. 1. a. Chairman Phyllis Guerette asked Superintendent Betsy Webb to update the Committee regarding LD 1274's changes to the Essential Programs and Services school funding formula and the impact on Bangor. Superintendent Webb explained that according to a spreadsheet prepared for the legislature, Bangor lost approximately \$184,000 in state subsidy from the changes to the formula.

2. f. Chairman Guerette appointed School Committee Member Beth Grant to the Penquis Funding Summit Planning Group.

To Bangor High School from Lippincott Books, 140 boxes of literature having an undetermined dollar value.


