The Bangor School Committee Special Meeting was called to order by Chairman Phyllis Guerette at 5:12 p.m. and the Pledge of Allegiance followed.

- A. A motion was made to enter Executive Session for the purpose of conducting an expulsion hearing according to 1 MRSA § 405 (6)(B).

By roll call the VOTE was unanimous (5-0) to enter Executive Session.


At 6 p.m., the committee reconvened into Public Session. School Committee Vice Chair Chris Szal read a School Committee resolution regarding Student X. The Bangor School Committee finds:

1. On June 8, 2010, Student X made a bomb threat at Bangor High School;
2. Student X's acted in a deliberately disobedient and in a deliberately disorderly manner and Student X committed an infraction of violence;
3. It is necessary for the peace and usefulness of the school to expel Student X.
4. Student X is expelled from the Bangor School Department.

The VOTE was unanimous (5-0) to accept the resolution and expel Student X.

The meeting adjourned at 6:02 p.m.
