

RESIDENT STUDENTS

Eligibility for enrollment of students in the Bangor School Department shall be as specified by Maine State Statutes.

Students who have received a high school diploma but who are under 20 years of age, may enroll only as full-time post-graduate students subject to such rules as the Superintendent may establish.

Participation in Bangor Adult Education courses shall be open to both resident and non-resident students, although a higher schedule of fees may be established for non-resident students.

Persons who are over the statutory age limits who wish to enroll as full-time high school students will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the School Committee upon the recommendation of the Superintendent.

A resident student's right to enroll in and attend school is subject to the Maine Department of Human Services' Immunization Requirements for School Children and the Bangor School Department's Immunization Policy. For the purposes of this policy a "resident student" includes a home-schooled student.
