### September

Make an appointment to see your counselor!

Seek-out Guidance Scholarship Book

Attend College Fair at U Maine Field House

Have parent/guardian attend the Parent Workshop

Create an organization plan to keep track of application and testing deadlines, financial aid forms required, and the number of recommendations required for the colleges you are applying to.

### October - December

-Turn in Counselor Recommendation form to Guidance

-Complete college applications and make copies

-Send test scores to colleges *if official test scores are required* and you haven't already had them sent.

-Bring the Secondary School Reports (SSR) to guidance or request that a transcript be sent for applications w/o SSR's.

### November

Note Early Decision & Early Action deadlines (if applicable)

Does the college require the CSS Profile?

### December

Attend Financial Aid Workshop

### January - February

Complete and send in the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (the F.A.F.S.A.) and the CSS Profile (if necessary)

### February

Complete the B.H.S. Scholarship Application and turn in to the Guidance Office.

### April

Expect to receive Financial aid awards and acceptance letters from colleges by mid-April.

Keep grades up! Colleges review final transcripts!

### May

-Notify every college of your acceptance or rejection of their offer of admission by May 1<sup>st</sup>.

-Send deposit to the college you plan to attend.

-Let your counselor know about your college choice!
