

MAINE LEARNING RESULTS

The Bangor School Department recognizes the Maine Learning Results as a set of standards that provides a state-wide basis for the assessment of student learning, public accountability and curricular equity. The Bangor School Committee recognizes that the legislative intent of the system of learning results is also to provide students with schools that reflect high expectations and create conditions where these expectations can be met.

The Bangor School Department understands that implementation of the system of learning results system will have implications for curriculum, budget, professional development, student assessment, professional evaluation, and graduation requirements. However, the system of learning results will not define or dictate the design or implementation of local curriculum and instruction, nor will it prescribe the methods or performance standards of the required local Assessment System. The School Department ensures that school practices are consistent with statutory guidelines and will aggregate Content Standard data of the Maine Learning Results to assist in evaluating the quality of student achievement in the Content Areas.

Implementation of the Maine Learning Results system will be included in the annual Comprehensive Educational Plan of the school department, and the Superintendent will work with the school department faculty, School Committee, and other invited contributors to develop appropriate administrative procedures. The Superintendent will report to the School Committee annually on progress toward implementing the system of learning results.
