

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The Bangor School Department will provide transportation to the schools operated by the Department for the following students:

- (a) All resident students in Kindergarten through Grade 3 who reside more than one (1) mile from the school to which assigned.
- (b) All resident students in Grades 4 through 8 who reside more than one and one-half (1.5) miles from the school to which assigned.
- (c) All resident students in Grades 9 through 12 who reside more than one and three-quarters (1.75) miles from the school to which assigned.
- (d) Special education and/or physically handicapped students may be transported within these limits where such transportation is deemed necessary by the Director of Pupil Services.
- (e) Students within these limits will be transported where the Superintendent of Schools has established routes due to unusually hazardous conditions. Such determination may include but need not be limited to consideration of: age of students, location of bus stop, safety of and distance from residence to bus stop, absence of sidewalks, and traffic.

Transportation routes shall be reviewed annually by the Superintendent and routes revised as necessary to reflect changes in road conditions and the provisions of the approved Bangor School Department budget.

The Bangor School Department shall not be responsible for transporting non-resident students and students assigned to a school outside their normal attendance area at the request of the student and/or parent. However, such students may ride on established Bangor School Department routes on a “space available” basis with the approval of the Director of Business Services.
