
INTERSCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS ADMISSION FEES

Interscholastic athletics are considered to be an essential part of the instructional program provided by the Bangor School Department in pursuit of its mission of academic excellence for all students. High expectations for student performance and aspirations are essential to the educational development of each student and unprecedented success of the athletic programs. Participation in athletics should also provide students with opportunities for self-discipline, self-sacrifice, and loyalty to the community, school, and team. While skills development and participation in athletic competition are the primary purposes of interscholastic athletics, it is recognized that spectator events are an appropriate part of the sports program.

Admission fees for varsity athletic contests should encourage attendance by interested persons while generating reasonable revenue for the Bangor School Department. Therefore, the following policies shall be observed:

1. Admission shall be charged for -

- Varsity Football games
- Varsity Basketball games (boys and girls)
- Varsity Swimming meets (boys and girls)
- Varsity Ice Hockey
- Varsity Soccer games (boys and girls)

2. Admission fees shall be -

Adults	\$5.00 per event or \$50 for year
Students in grades 6-12	\$3.00 per event or \$25 for year
Students in grades K-5	Free if accompanied by an adult; otherwise \$3.00 per event
Children less than school age	Free but must be accompanied by an adult
Employees of the Bangor School Department & Bangor School Committee	Athletic pass*; free annual validation
Senior Citizens (Age 65+)	\$3.00 or for Bangor Residents free upon presentation of a Senior Citizens Identification Card

*Note: College recruiters, scouts, and officials of visiting teams shall be admitted under reciprocal agreements as approved by the Principal. Athletic passes shall not provide free admission pre-season or post-season tournament contests in any sport. The School Committee reserves the right to modify or cancel the athletic season pass system at any time.

High school students may earn a season pass through school or community service approved by school principal.
