## CO-CURRICULAR AND INTERSCHOLASTIC PROGRAMS

---

Co-curricular, interscholastic, and school social activities are encouraged, subject to such regulations as may be established by the Superintendent and applicable school principal, as may be appropriate to the age and interests of students.

All school-sponsored activities shall be under the direct supervision of a school department employee or volunteer as authorized by the principal for co-curricular and social activities or Superintendent for interscholastic programs.

Co-curricular, interscholastic, and school social activities, including but not limited to rehearsals, practices, performances, games and contests, shall be scheduled within the following guidelines unless otherwise authorized by the Superintendent of Schools to meet unique circumstances:

Elementary school activities shall be scheduled to end by 5:00 p.m. However, PTO nights may be scheduled to end by 7:00 p.m. on non-school nights and PEAK nights may be scheduled to end by 7:00 p.m. on school nights when necessary. Grade 4-5 concerts may begin at 7:00 p.m. and end by 8:00 p.m.

Middle School activities shall be scheduled to end by 7:00 p.m.

However, Middle School performances may be scheduled to end by 9:30 p.m. and Middle School social activities may be scheduled on non-school nights to end by 9:30 p.m.

High School activities shall be scheduled to end by 9:30 p.m.

However, High School performances and games may be scheduled to end by 10:30 p.m. and High School social activities may be scheduled on non-school nights to end by 11:30 p.m. Away games or activities may require later travel times and advisors and school administration will communicate this ahead of time to parents.

School-sponsored activities shall not be scheduled on Sundays.

Adult and Community Education activities; including sports and social programs, shall be scheduled to end by 7:00 p.m. for participants of elementary school age, 8:00 p.m. for participants of middle school age, and 9:30 for participants of high school age.
