
COMPARABILITY OF INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES AMONG SCHOOLS

The Bangor School Department shall comply with Section 1118 (c) of the Elementary and Secondary Schools Act (ESEA)/Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) and shall provide comparable services, curriculum, and instructional materials and supplies, and staffing levels in Title I eligible and non-Title I eligible schools using local and state funds. The Bangor School Department shall ensure equivalence among schools in teachers, administrators, other staff, and the provision of both curriculum resources and instructional supplies. In all schools, students shall be eligible for supplemental supports and comparable programs. District salary schedules for both professional and non-professional staff shall be maintained and utilized.

This policy does not restrict the Bangor School Department from addressing a determined need at an individual school.

The Superintendent of Schools or his/her/their* designee shall develop procedures for compliance with this policy and shall maintain records that are updated biennially documenting the Bangor School Department's compliance with this policy.
