

HOMEBOUND AND/OR HOSPITAL INSTRUCTION

The Bangor School Department will provide homebound and/or hospital instruction to Bangor residents when a physician has stated in writing a medical reason for confinement, as well as stating an expectation that the confinement will continue for at least ten (10) consecutive school days.

The physician's statement should be sent to the Office of Pupil Services. Homebound instruction will be requested by the Director of Pupil Services or a designee upon receipt of the physician's written recommendation. The Director of Pupil Services will be responsible for securing the services of a tutor.

Homebound instruction may also be provided for other than medical reasons per recommendation of a Bangor Individualized Education Program Team and subject to approval by the Superintendent of Schools or a designee.

Qualifications for homebound or hospital tutors will be as stipulated by State of Maine regulations.
